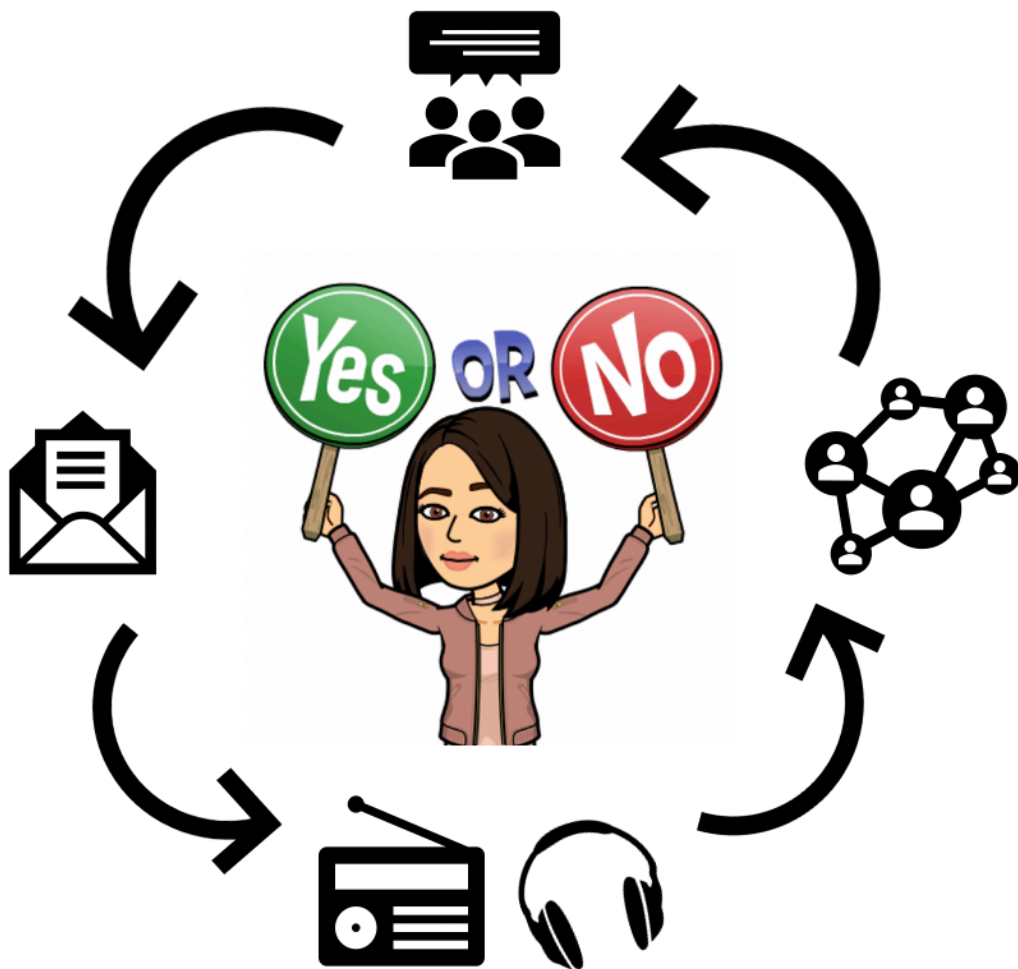

The bomb exploded as he was escaping to the street. Fortunately, nobody was injured / hurt.

4) Ils n'ont jamais fait de parapente, mais ils ont déjà essayé le delta plane.

They have never done paragliding, but they've already tried hang gliding.

5) Je partageais un appartement avec mon meilleur ami à ce moment-là, mais j'ai déménagé à la campagne il y a deux mois.

I was sharing a flat with my best friend at that moment, but I moved in / to the countryside two months ago.

I didn't mind studying when I was at school, but I preferred holidays, of course.
